The second day—the sky was created

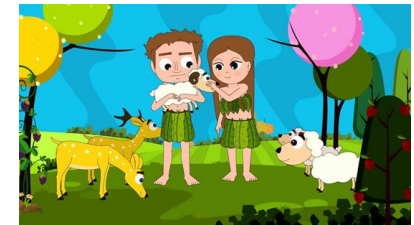
The third day—dry land, seas, plants and trees were created

The sixth day— animals that live on the land and finally humans, made in the image of God were created

On day seven—God finished his work of creation and rested, making the seventh day a special holy day. For Christians, this is Sunday. The seven days make up one week.
