Physical features – geographical features that have been made by nature.



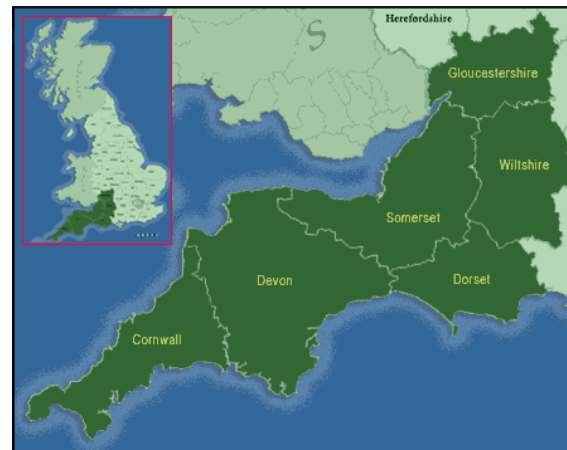
Human features – geographical features that have been made by humans.

South West England is one of nine official regions of England. It is the largest in area, covering 9,200 square miles (23,800 km²) and the counties of Gloucestershire, Bristol, Wiltshire, Somerset, Dorset, Devon and Cornwall, as well as the Isles of Scilly. Five million people live in South West England.

Stonehenge – Stonehenge is a human feature that can be found in Salisbury. Stonehenge is suspected to be over five thousand years old.
