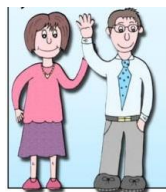


## Connecting computers

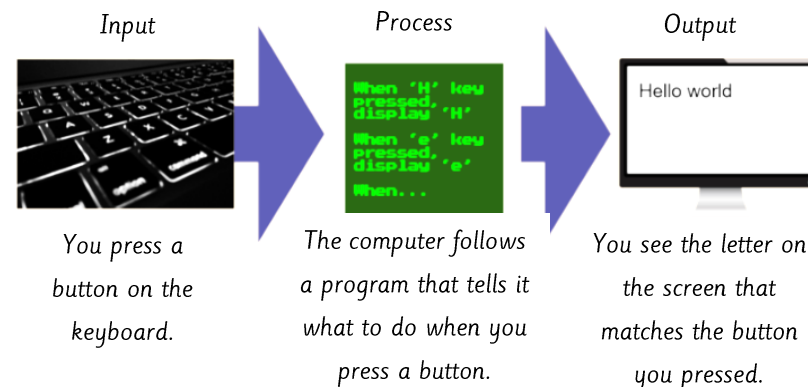
Key Vocabulary	Definition
Devices	Different appliances that can be used to access the internet.
Digital	Expressed in a series of digits 1 and 0 / relating to, using or storing data or information using digital signals/ involving or relating to the use of computer technology.
Input	Information fed into a data processing system or computer.
Internet Safety	Protecting yourself while on the internet.
Networks	A computer network is a number of computers linked together to allow them to "talk" to each other and share resources.
Output	You see or hear what you have done e.g. letters appear on a screen.
Process	The computer follows a programme that tells it what to do.

### E-safety – Follow these E-safety tips to be safe online!

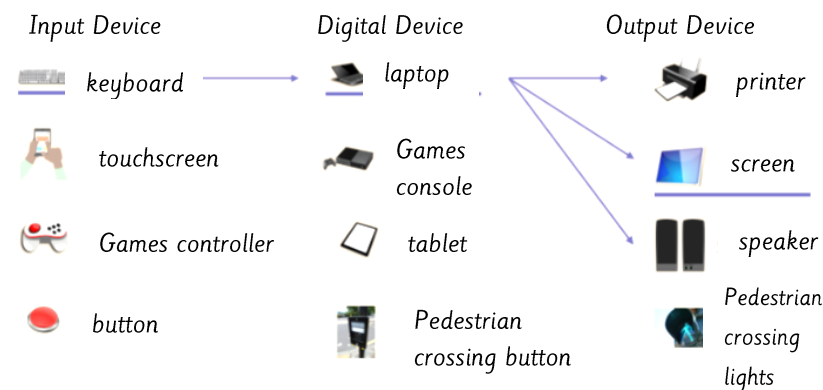
<b>S</b>	Stay safe- Keep your personal information to yourself. Do not share your age or address. Only be friends with people you know in real life.
<b>M</b>	Meeting someone you have only spoken to online can be dangerous. Always check with an adult you trust
<b>A</b>	Accepting files, emails, pictures of texts from people you don't know can cause problems.
<b>R</b>	Check information before you believe it. Is the person or the website telling the truth?
<b>T</b>	Tell an adult if something or someone makes you feel worried or uncomfortable.
