Key Vocabulary –

Denominator – The bottom part of the fraction, how many parts there are in total.

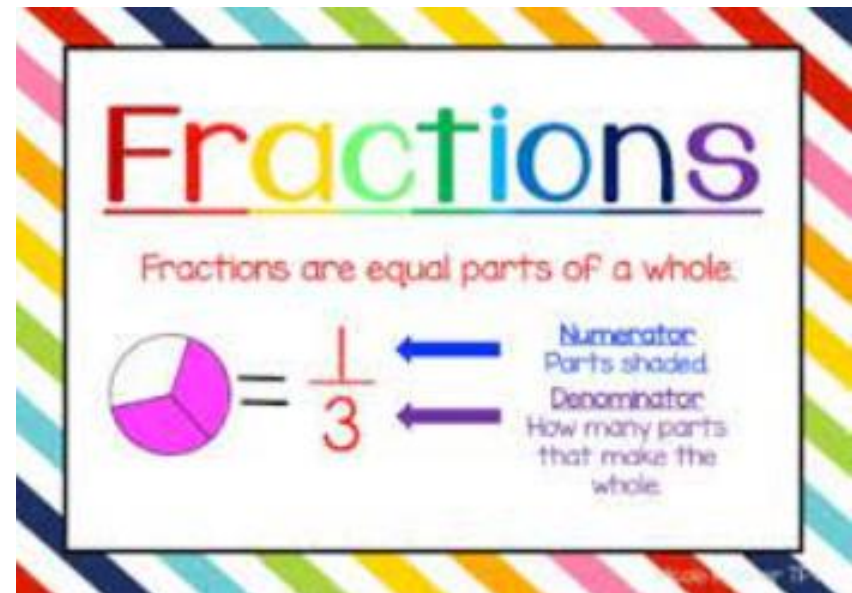
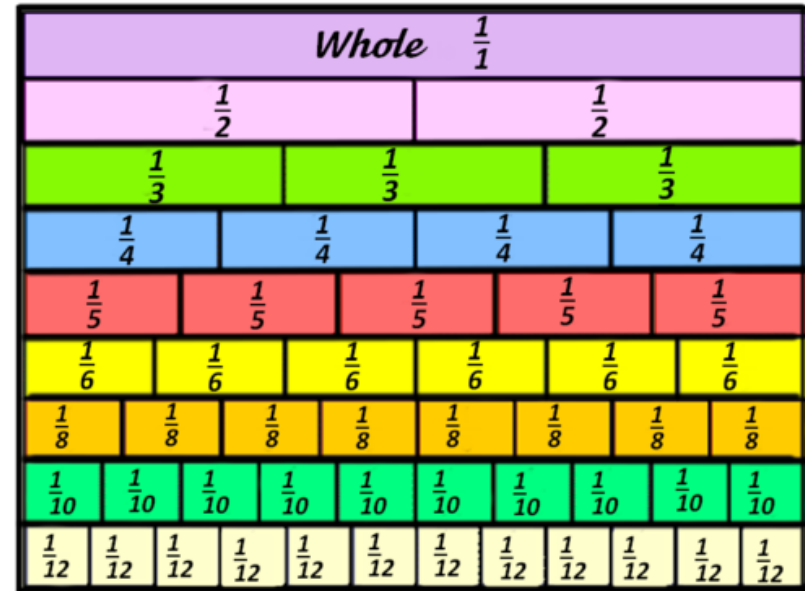
Numerator – The top part of the fraction, how many parts we have.

Right angle – An angle of exactly 90 degrees.

Obtuse angle – An angle that is greater than 90 degrees.

Acute Angle – An angle that is less than 90 degrees.
