Rhythm – a strong and regular repeated pattern of sound.

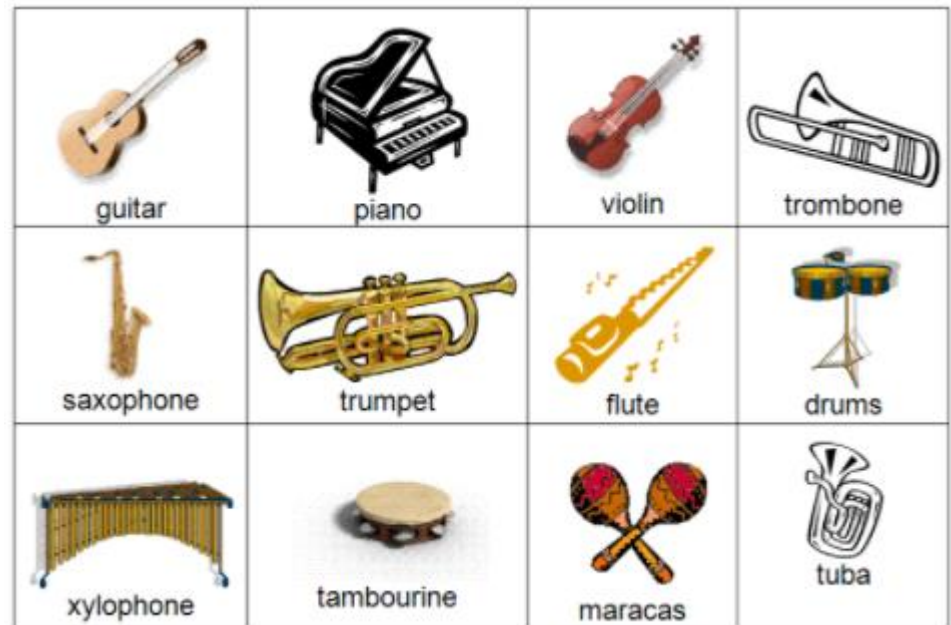
Tone – a reference to the pitch or strength of a sound.
