Bat Mitzvah – A coming of age ritual for girls.

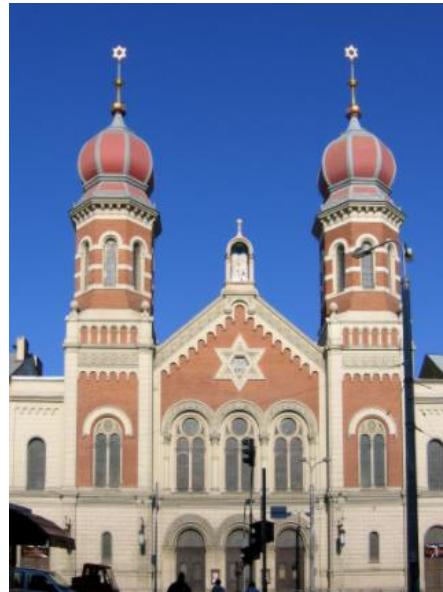
Rabbi – a spiritual leader in the Jewish faith.
