
Jazz

Improvisation is where you make up your own tunes on the spot. This can be done using musical instruments, voices or clapping. Improvisation is not written down and is a tune that has not been heard before. Everyone can improvise and it can be done individually or with other people.



Graphic Score

A graphic score is an exciting and creative way to write musical composition. It involves using shapes, squiggles, letters and pic-



tures. With graphic score you can make up your own rules and can be as imaginative as you want to be.

Musical styles.

This unit introduces 3 different musical styles:

Rap—rap music includes rhyme and is delivered using rhythmic speech. Rap is usually performed with a backing beat or a musical accompaniment.

Jazz—Jazz music is performed with different woodwind instruments. Jazz is performed using a lot of improvisation.

Pop— pop music is short for popular music. It is any type of music which is listened to all around the world.
