Invasion	Entering a place with force, usually to try and take control
colony	In history, a colony is a territory under the immediate complete political control and occupied by settlers of a foreign country.
The Spanish Armada	A fleet of ships owned by the Spanish
Circumnavigate	Travel the whole way around the globe.
Privateer	A privateer is a private person or ship that engages in maritime warfare under a commission of war.
Roanoke Island	The Roanoke Colony refers to two attempts by Sir Walter Raleigh to found the first permanent English settlement in North America.



Francis Drake

was an English sea captain, privateer, naval officer, slaver, and explorer. Drake is best known for his circumnavigation of the world in a single expedition, from 1577 to 1580.



Walter Raleigh

Raleigh was instrumental in the English colonisation of North America and was granted a [royal patent](#) to explore [Virginia](#), paving the way for future English settlements.



The Armada Portrait commemorates the most famous conflict of Elizabeth I's reign – the failed invasion of England by the Spanish Armada in summer 1588.
