
Please remember that girls have the options of wearing shorts, skorts, trousers...or (longer) skirts; thank you to all of the girls who already do this.

YEAR SIX TRIP:

On Thursday 28th September, Year 6 were invited to take part in the National Manufacturing Day by Breckland Council. We visited 'Peerless Plastics and Coatings' on Howlett Way in Thetford before going to complete more activities at the Charles Burrrell Centre.



At the factory we were shown around by Mr Llewellyn-Stamp, the Managing Director. He explained the various processes the pieces of plastic they work with go through. An interesting fact we learned is that every Boeing plane with glow-in-the-dark strips on the floor has a connection to Thetford. All those strips are coated in Peerless Plastics and Coatings' factory!

When we entered the part of the factory that deals with the finishing touches, we had to wear hairnets. This was because of the amount of static electricity in this area, and to alleviate the likelihood of hairs getting drawn to the

wet plastic coatings.

Boniface Engineering, Baxter's Healthcare and West Suffolk College were all at the Charles Burrell Centre, and we got to take part in two of the three activities on offer. The representative from Boniface Engineering explained about all the processes their



engineers go through when designing and building low-loader lorries and trucks, while Baxter's Healthcare had us dressing up in protective gear. West

Suffolk College spoke to us about the processes a tin of beans goes through. We discovered the strongest shape is a sphere, but spherical tins would not be very good for

transportation which is why

cylindrical tins are used. The ridges in the tins give more strength to the shape.

It was an informative morning out, and we hope Breckland Council give us the opportunity to join in with National Manufacturing Day next year.
