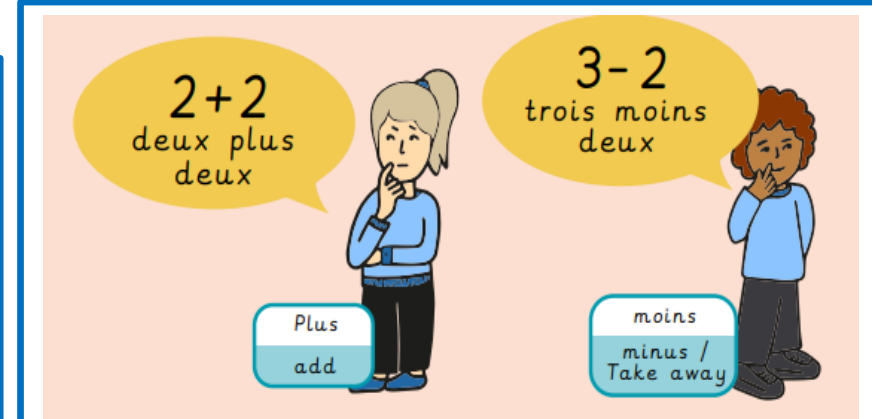
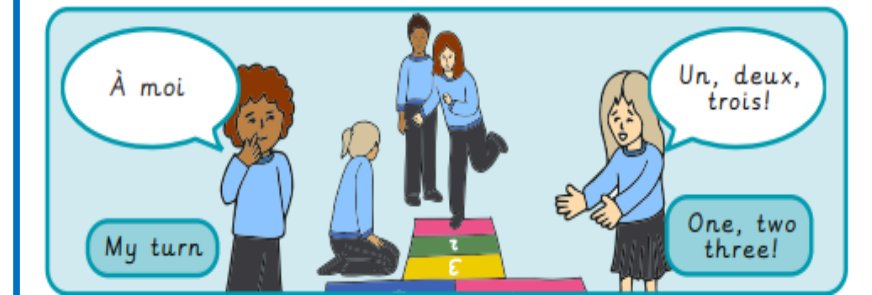

Plus - add - is used when adding two or more numbers together this time the "s" is pronounced. Also means 'more'

trois **plus** deux font cinq

three add two makes/equals five

$$\begin{array}{c} \bullet \\ \bullet \end{array} + \begin{array}{c} \bullet \end{array} = \begin{array}{c} \bullet \bullet \\ \bullet \end{array}$$

Moins - minus / take away - is used when subtracting two or more numbers. Also means 'less'.

neuf **moins** trois font six

nine minus three makes/equals six
