## What makes a community?

Living in a diverse community means that we are surrounded by several different cultures and experiences.



Key Vocabulary	Definition
<b>Community</b>	A group of people living in the same place or having a particular characteristic in common
<b>Contributions</b>	A gift or payment to a common fund or collection.
<b>Culture</b>	The ideas, customs, and social behaviour of a particular people or society.
<b>Discrimination</b>	Discrimination means to treat a person or group of people unfairly, especially on the basis of certain characteristics, such as race, religion, age, sex, disability or gender.
<b>Diversity</b>	A range of different things.
<b>Prejudice</b>	A preconceived opinion that is not based on reason or actual experience
<b>Segregated</b>	Separated or divided along racial, sexual, or religious lines.
<b>Society</b>	The aggregate of people living together in a more or less ordered community.
<b>Stereotype</b>	A stereotype is a fixed, oversimplified idea about a particular type of person or thing. Stereotypes are often harmful to the people or things they refer to.

It should not happen but people can be discriminated by their age, gender, race, religion and disability.



Segregation is the separation of people because of their race, gender or religion.
