Key Vocabulary	Definition
Money	An exchange in the form of notes and coins.
Pence	Referring to a sum of money.
Pounds	Referring to a sum of money.
Notes	A form of currency in the form of paper.
Coins	A form of currency in the form of a piece of metal.
Change	The money returned after paying for something with more money than it costs.
Amounts	The total that something might cost.
Double	To add the same amount again.
Half	Consisting of 2 equal parts.
Multiplication	A method of finding the product of two or more numbers.
Division	Separating something into parts.
Equal	Being the same as.
Odd	Having one left over as a remainder when dividing by 2.
Even	Divisible by 2 without having a remainder.

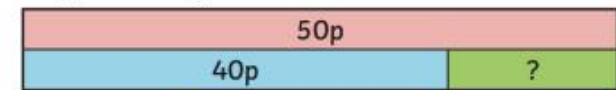

Find the change



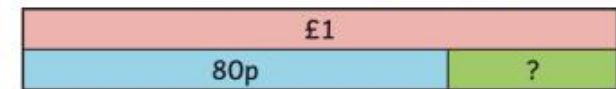
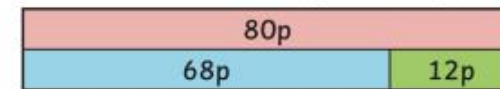
Lucy bought a jigsaw with a 50p coin. How much change did she get?
