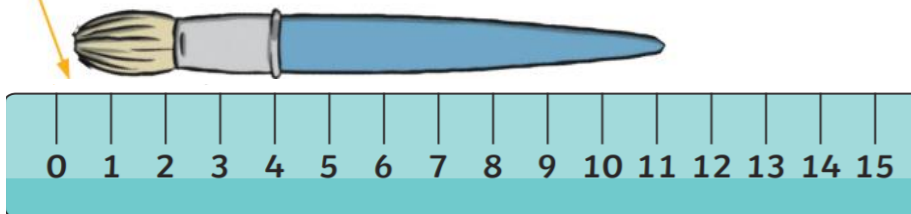
Mental addition and subtraction (to 20)

Fractions

Equal parts- when an object or number is divided into equal parts or groups.

Equivalent- fractions that are the same value.

Numerator- how many equal parts of the whole are needed.

Denominator- how many equal parts in a whole.

Order- to put in size order.

Longer than and shorter than- used when comparing objects.

Quarter turn- a turn of 90 degrees.

Half turn- a turn of 180 degrees.

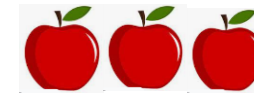
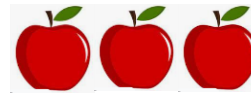
Three quarters turn- a turn of 270 degrees.

Pattern- a repeated design.

Sequence- a repeated pattern.

Fractions

A fraction is part of a whole.



Half-is splitting a whole into 2 equal parts. $6 \div 2 = 3$



Quarters- is splitting a whole into 4 equal parts. $8 \div 4 = 2$



Thirds-is splitting a whole into 3 equal parts. $6 \div 3 = 2$
