
Key Vocabulary	Definition
Compose	To create a piece of music and usually record it so it can repeat.
Improvise	To compose in the moment or make up as you go along.
Melody	A series of notes played in an order that is memorable and recognisable in itself.
Notation	The visual record of music that can be heard.
Perform	Showing an audience what you can do.
Pitch	How high or low a note is.
Popular music	A genre of popular music that originated in its modern form during the mid-1950s in the United
	States and the United Kingdom.
Pulse	A steady beat that doesn't change. The heartbeat of the music.
Rhythm	How notes of different length are arranged into a pattern.
Rock	The Rock and Roll definition can be described as a type of popular dance music that originated
	in the 1950s. Rock and Roll is characterized by a heavy beat and uncomplicated melodies. It
	first emerged as a fusion of rhythm and blues with country music.
Soul	Soul music is a genre rooted in African American culture, blending rhythm and blues with gospel
	elements. It expresses deep emotions, often focusing on love, pain, and resilience.
Tempo	The speed of a piece of music—is it fast, slow, walking pace.
