### Hadrian's wall

The Roman's built a wall to keep other tribes away from their land. It was called Hadrian's wall and was 117km long.

**Roman Empire**- The name used for the land that was controlled by the Romans.

**Emperor**- The ruler of an Empire.

**Legion**- A large section of a Roman army, made up of 5000 soldiers.

**Celts**- People living in Britain.

**Iceni**- A tribe of Celts who lived in the east of Britain.

**Boudicca**- The Queen of the Iceni tribe.

**Forum**- The area where Romans, would meet, shop and trade.

**Basilica**- The area in front of the forum.

### Roman Roads

The Romans were famous for building long, straight roads to transport legions, supplies, trading goods and messages from the emperor. You can still see some Roman roads today, 2000 years after they were built.
