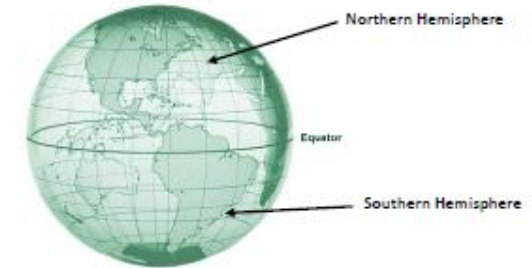
A map of the world



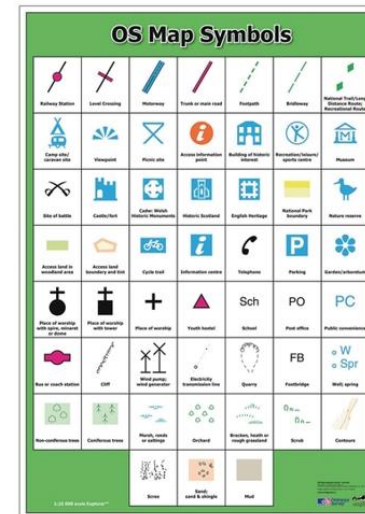
| Key Vocabulary | Definition |
|------------------------|---|
| Destination | The place that you want to go to. |
| Directions | How to get to somewhere. |
| Equator | An imaginary line around the earth that divides the Northern Hemisphere from the Southern Hemisphere |
| Globe | A 3D representation of the world. |
| Landmarks | An object or a feature of a landscape or town that has importance or makes a place easily recognizable |
| Location | The place where something is. |
| Map | A 2D representation that shows where places are located. |
| Ordnance survey | An organisation that produces detailed maps in the UK. |
| Scale | The size of a map compared to the actual size of the area it is showing: maps are much smaller than the real places they show |
| Symbols | Small pictures that are used to represent geographical features. |
