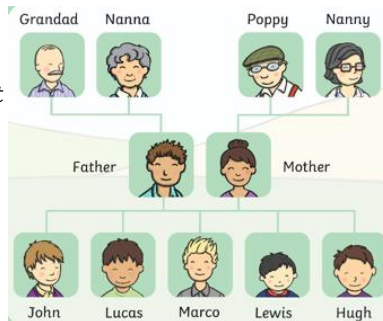
Discovering History

Key Vocabulary	Definition
archaeologist	A person who looks in the ground for clues about the past.
artefact	An object made and used a long time ago.

evidence	A collection of facts, information or objects that suggests whether something is true or false.

What Is History?

History is the study of the past - the last 6,000 years, approximately, from the first evidence of human writing. Anything before this is known as prehistory. Studying history allows us to discover the people, places and events of the past that have helped to shape the present day. The reason we learn about history is so we can understand where we have come from. It also helps us understand that things are always changing and a lot of the time that makes life better.

To be a historian, you have to act as a detective, search for clues about the past and put them together to find out what happened. Historians use different sources from history to be able to uncover stories about the past and find out how people lived at different points in time.

What is a source in history?



A source is anything that contains information about the past.

Sources of evidence include;

Artefacts - such as bones, pottery, weapons, tools, coins and art

Images - photographs and film from recent history

Writing - including inscriptions carved in stone, writing on walls, journals, newspapers and diaries.

Oral - stories which have been passed down through the generations.
