<b>Christmas</b>	The annual festival of the Christian church commemorating the birth of Jesus, celebrated on December 25 <sup>th</sup> and observed in the UK as a national holiday.
<b>Frankincense</b>	An aromatic (nice smelling) resin used in incense and perfume. This resin comes from trees. Its name comes from the old French word <i>franc</i> meaning noble and pure. Expensive.
<b>Gifts</b>	Something given voluntarily without payment in return, as to show favour toward someone honour an occasion.
<b>Gold</b>	A precious metal of high value.
<b>Jesus</b>	Christians believe that Jesus is the son of God, born to Mary and Joseph.
<b>Myrrh</b>	A resin used throughout history in perfume, incense and medicine. Expensive.
<b>Received</b>	To have been given a gift.
<b>Special</b>	Better, greater or otherwise different to what is usual.
