### Human rights

The basic needs of all humans throughout the world are:

- food;
- water;
- shelter;
- to be safe;
- to feel happy;
- to have the opportunity to learn and develop.



The United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC) is a significant international human rights treaty that outlines the rights of children across the globe.

It has 4 underlying principles:

- **Non-discrimination:** Ensures equal rights for all children.
- **Best interest of the child:** Prioritizes the child's well-being in all decisions.
- **Right to life, survival, and development:** Protects children's right to grow and thrive.
- **Right to be heard:** Gives children a voice in matters affecting them.

### Children have the right to:

- be protected;
- have an education;
- have access to doctors and medicine;
- have the things they need to be safe and comfortable at home;
- be heard and taken seriously.

| accept                 | When you accept something, you willingly take or receive it. Accept can also mean believing it to be true or recognising it as normal. |
| anti-bullying          | Working with others to stop bullies from hurting others. Being against bullying.   |
| Anti-Bullying Alliance | This is a charity that works to promote the end of bullying among children.  |
| belong                 | To be in the right place or a suitable place. When you feel happy or comfortable in a situation, you can say you belong there.         |
| bully                  | Someone who deliberately tries to hurt another person, either by using words or their body.  |
