Exploring Feelings When We Play

How can music make us feel?

Sometimes, the music we hear highlights the words we are singing. There might be a special effect in the music on a particular song lyric to make that word stand out. Special effects in music can make the words we sing more meaningful. The sounds that we hear in music can also help to communicate specific moods.

Understanding Music

Key Signature: F major – there is one flat in the key signature.
Rhythmic Patterns using: Minims, crotchets, dotted crotchets, quavers and Semi-quavers.
Tempo: Andante – at walking pace (97 bpm)
Time Signature: 2/4 – there are two crotchet beats in a bar.

Improvising Together

Key Signature: C major – no sharps or flats.
Notes: C D E G A

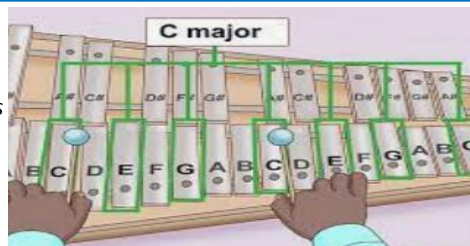


Time Signature: 4/4 – there are two crotchet beats in a bar.

Key Vocabulary	Definition
beats	The steady pulse of a piece of music. It is what you clap to when you hear a piece of music.
compose	To put together or create a piece of music.
dynamics	The volume of music.
emotions	How you feel.
evoke	To call or summon up a memory or feeling.
hook	A musical phrase that stands out and is easily remembered.
improvise	Making up music on the spot using your voice, musical instruments or everyday objects.
key signature	If there are any sharp notes or flat notes in the music.
melody	Another name for a tune.
pitch	How high or low a note sounds
pulse	The number of beats per minute in a piece of music. It is like the heartbeat of a piece of music.
respond	Our reaction to a piece of music.
rhythm	The long and short sounds in the music.
solo	Playing, singing or performing on your own.
tempo	The speed the music is played at.
time signatures	Shows a musician how many beats there are in each bar.
unison	Everyone playing or singing the same notes at the same time.

What is a glockenspiel?

The Glockenspiel is a percussion instrument. It has pitched notes that are set out like a keyboard. It is the different lengths of the metal bars that produce the different notes of the glockenspiel as they are hit. The longer the metal bar is, the lower the note produced
