<i>consequence</i>	Things that happen as a result of something else.
<i>culture</i>	The food, clothes, language and traditions people enjoy.
<i>diverse</i>	Made up of lots of different things
<i>environment</i>	The world around us, including the land, sea, sky, plants, animals and people. Environments can be natural or built.
<i>listen</i>	Hearing and concentrating on what someone is saying.
<i>multicultural</i>	A group of people from many different cultures.
<i>neighbourhood</i>	The area near and around where we live
<i>neighbours</i>	People who live and work in our local community.
<i>respect</i>	A way of treating or thinking about someone that shows they are important and they are valued.
<i>responsibilities</i>	Tasks that we do to contribute or things we are in charge of.

To look after our neighbourhood, we need to look after the natural and built environment that is local to us. People have the right to live somewhere clean and safe, where they can be healthy. We have a responsibility to look after our neighbourhood to help make sure all people and other living things have a comfortable home.
