Information Technology

Technology is the name for man-made things that help us. **Information technology (IT)** is made up of computers and things that work with computers.

IT includes computers – desktop computers, laptops, games consoles, smartphones and tables.

IT also includes devices that work with computers – USB sticks, SMART boards and digital cameras.

appliances	A device or piece of equipment designed to perform a specific task.
barcode	A machine-readable code in the form of numbers and a pattern of parallel lines of varying widths, printed on a commodity and used especially for stock control
communication	A means of sending or receiving information, such as phone lines or computers
computer	An electronic device for storing and processing data, typically in binary form, according to instructions given to it in a variable program.
devices	Different appliances that can be used to access the internet.
entertainment	The action of providing or being provided with amusement or enjoyment
information technology (IT)	The use of computer systems or devices to access information.
internet safety	Protecting yourself while on the internet.
scanner	A device that scans documents and converts them into digital data.
signal	An electrical impulse or radio wave transmitted or received

Control the tools and appliances that are in the home: The panel for the heating, setting the washing machine and programming the microwave.

Help us communicate with one another: The internet and the telephone.

Entertain us: toys and computer consoles.

In cash machines: the bank card and PIN card reader help you access your bank account.

On roads: traffic lights, buttons, and signals work together to tell you when to cross the road.
