Suffixes

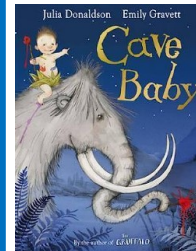
A suffix is a group of letters which go on the end of a word to create a new meaning. The suffixes we will be focusing on are s/es, ing, ed, er and est:

Cave Baby

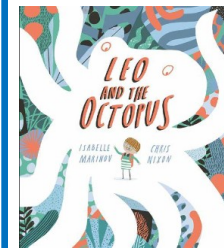
