Season (seasonal)	Each of the 4 divisions of the year. Seasonal applies to the weather expected during that season.
Spring	The season after winter and before summer. When things begin to grow.
Summer	The season after spring and before Autumn. The weather is usually hottest in the Summer.
Autumn	The season after summer and before winter. Characterised by leaves turning brown and falling from the trees.
Winter	The season after autumn and before spring. Usually the coldest weather is in the winter.
Axis and tilt	Used to describe the off centre way in which the earth spins and orbits the sun.
Orbit	Describes the movement of the earth, in an ellipse around the sun.
Graph	A way of showing data as a picture.
Measure	To find out how much there is of something.
Record	To write down what you have found out.
Data	Quantities you have measured.
Droplet	A small drop of liquid.

Storm	Weather that is cold and wet with very strong winds
Cirrus clouds	Whispy clouds; In latin cirrus means curly hair. 
stratus	From the latin stratus meaning layer. 
cumulus	From the latin cumulus meaning pile or heap.
