



The specific School Homework Expectations for Year 3 are:

**Weekly spellings:** Released on Friday. Tested on Thursday.

**Weekly X tables/number facts:** Terrible Times Tables tested on Tuesday

Children to practise **1-minute maths** accessible on the app store.

**Daily reading logged and signed:** Homework books and reading records due on Mondays.

### **Geography- South West England**

Look at pictures of places in the South West (Stonehenge, beaches, Dartmoor). Children design a postcard as if they visited one place. Write or dictate a short message: "Today I saw..."

### **Science- light**

#### **1. Use mirrors (or foil on cardboard) to reflect a torch beam.**

Try to guide the light to hit a target.

Talk about how light bounces (reflection).

#### **2. Light & Dark Hunt**

Walk around the house or garden finding light sources and dark/shady places.

Sort pictures or objects into "light" and "dark."

### **History- Law and power**

Use tea-stained paper to make an "old" scroll. Write or draw simple rules like "The king must be fair." Roll it up and tie with string; talk about why rules matter.

### **RE- Could Jesus really perform miracles?**

Talk about modern-day "miracles" like kindness and helping others. Create a chart where children add acts of kindness they do during the week.

### **Ancient Egyptian Art**

Create side-profile portraits using crayons or paint. Add crowns, jewellery, and symbols.

### **Spelling**

Children choose spelling words. Adults help create a word search grid. Children decorate and swap puzzles with family members.
