Welcome back to Firecrests class. Here is your exciting optional homework opportunities.

**Weekly spellings:** Tested on Thursday. Spellings sent out on Dojo at the start of every half term.

Optional homework choices:

Science – **Magnetic Maze:** Create a maze on a piece of paper or cardboard. Use a magnet underneath the surface to move a paperclip through the maze without touching it. (Let Team Firecrests adults know if your grown-ups don't have a magnet at home).

History – **Tudor Portraits or Tudor Houses – You choose!**

**Tudor Portraits:** Draw or paint portraits of Tudor monarchs. Discuss what they might have worn or what their surroundings might have looked like.

**Tudor Houses:** Create a model of a Tudor house using cardboard, paper, and other craft materials. Discuss the different parts of a Tudor house and how people lived.

Life skills – “My Safety Superhero Poster” Create a Safety Superhero Poster that shows five ways you can keep yourself safe. Your poster should include ways to keep yourself safe with: meeting new people, medicines, fire, 999 calls, and online.

DT – Help to make a healthy meal at home. What did you make? Did you enjoy it? What would you do better next time?

Maths & RE – Make some Easter biscuits and decorate them. For maths, make sure you get involved with the weighing, measuring and cooking. Which was the heaviest ingredient? Which was the lightest? Did you have to weigh anything by volume (ml)? What temperature did you need to cook them at? For RE, think about what shape and decorations you will use on the biscuits. How do they represent Easter and the Christian beliefs about them? If you would like to, you can bring in your biscuits to give to the other children to take home and eat.
