**un** is used for masculine singular nouns.

**un** crayon = masculine

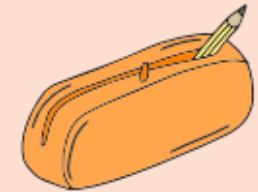
a pencil

**une** trousse = feminine

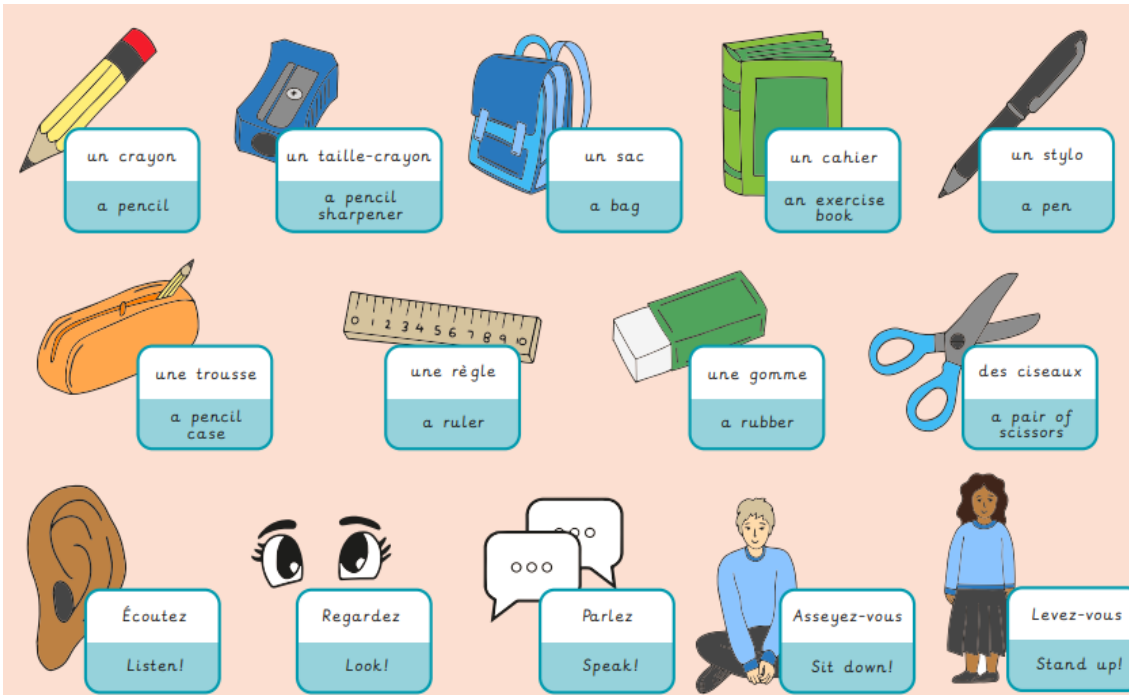
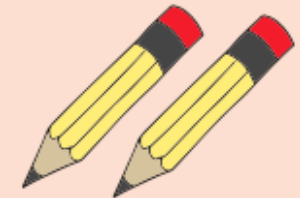
a pencil case
