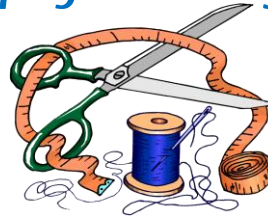

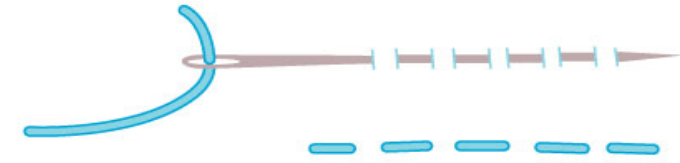

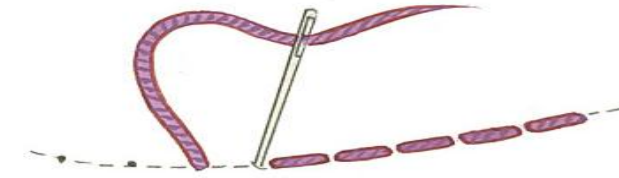


Key Vocabulary	Definition
aesthetic	The beauty of something – how it looks.
appliqué	The process of stitching pieces of material onto another piece of fabric.
embroidery	The process of sewing designs onto a piece of fabric.
fast fashion	Cheap, low-quality clothing produced quickly to keep up with new trends.
fray	When the threads of a woven fabric start to unravel or wear thin.
functional	Something that serves a purpose – practical and usable.
hem	To fold and sew the edge of a fabric to help prevent it from fraying.
pattern	A paper template used as a guide to create a garment or textile item.
pinning	Using pins to temporarily hold fabrics in place before sewing.
recycle	Processing used things to allow them to be reused again.
seam	A line formed by sewing two pieces of fabric together.
sustainable	Able to keep going at the same rate or speed – environmentally friendly.
upcycle	To reuse (recycle) something to create a new, functional product.
waste	Objects that are thrown away or no longer have any use.

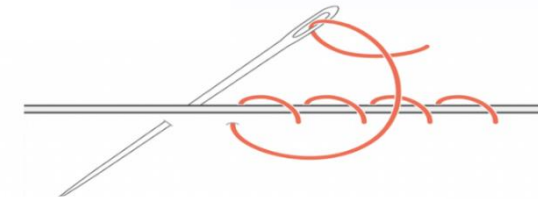
Types of stitching
