### What is a Synagogue?

A Synagogue is the place of worship for Jewish people. It is the place that Bar Mitzvahs and Bat Mitzvahs take place.



Key Vocabulary	Definition
<b>Bar Mitzvah</b>	A coming of age ceremony for Jewish boys. They are now responsible for their own actions.
<b>Bat Mitzvah</b>	A coming of age ceremony for Jewish girls. They are now responsible for their own actions.
<b>commitment</b>	Being dedicated to something, you are committed to it.
<b>community</b>	A group of people living in the same area.
<b>covenant</b>	A promise between God and Jewish people. If Jewish people follow the rules God has given them, He will look after them.
<b>identity</b>	Who a person is, or the qualities of a person or group that make them different from others.
<b>Jew</b>	A person who follows the Jewish religion.
<b>Mitzvah Day</b>	A day of social action, where Jews show their faith within their community.
<b>milestones</b>	An important event in the history or development of something or someone.
<b>synagogue</b>	The place of worship for Jews.
<b>Torah</b>	The Torah is the first part of the Jewish bible.
<b>Tu B'Shevat</b>	Tree planting ceremony.

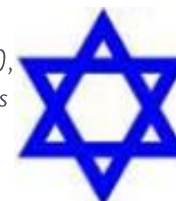
### What Is Mitzvah Day?
