Optional homework choices:

Maths – Fractions – fraction cooking (or you could use playdough or even paper. Practise making fractions of shapes by cutting out a round cookie from dough (or paper) and then cutting it in half, and then into quarters. What other fractions can you show? How do you know what fraction you have made? Can you show that  $\frac{1}{2} = \frac{2}{4}$ ?

English – Research the lifecycle of your favourite animal. Can you write or draw a diagram to show how it changes over its life?

Science – Grow and care for a plant. What does your plant need to grow and develop in a healthy way? What do you have to do to care for it?

Geography - Imagine you are Vikings exploring Northern Europe! Draw your Viking ship and write a short adventure story about visiting one of the countries. What treasure do you find? Who do you meet? (you could tell your adventure story orally, instead of writing if you want to. **Or**, research the food of Northern Europe and have a food tasting inspired by it. Tell us about your favourite treat.
