

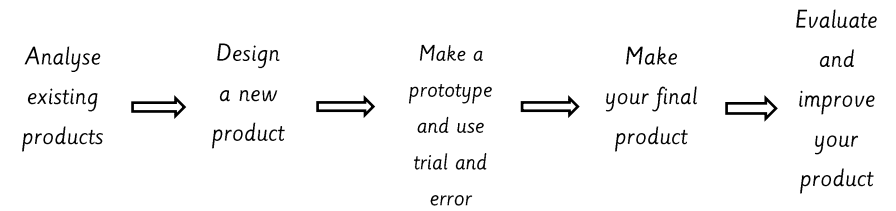

Felt Puppets

The design processes



Key Vocabulary	Definition
aesthetic	How something looks
design	A plan or drawing produced to show the look and function or workings of a building, garment, or other object before it is made
evaluation	Saying what was good and what could be better
fabric	Cloth made from threads- clothes are made from fabric
purpose	The reason for which something is done or created or for which something exists
seam	A line where two pieces of fabric are joined together, usually by stitching

Hand puppet examples



Running stitch

Start: Tie a knot in your thread or do a few small stitches on the back of the fabric.

Step 1: Push the needle up through the fabric.

Step 2: Push the needle back down near where you came up.

Step 3: Bring the needle up again a little further along.

Keep going up and down to make stitches.

Finish:

Turn to the back of the fabric.

Make two small stitches to secure the thread.

Pull through and make a knot.

Cut off the extra thread.

Running Stitch



Back stitch:

Start: Tie a knot or make a few small stitches on the back of the fabric.

Step 1: Push the needle up through the fabric.

Step 2: Push the needle back down near where you came up.

Step 3: Bring the needle up a little further along.

Step 4: Go back and push the needle down into the last stitch.

Step 5: Bring the needle up again a little further along.

Keep repeating steps 4 and 5.

Finish:

Turn to the back.

Make two small stitches to secure the thread.

Pull through to make a knot and cut the thread.

Types of puppets

Hand puppets



- Worn on your hand like a glove
- You move the mouth and arms

Finger puppets

- Small puppets that fit on your fingers
- Good for quick stories like 3 little pigs

- Template
- Needle
- Thread
- Fabric
- Scissors
