1 SOUND IT OUT

Say the word slowly.
Listen for each sound
and say the sounds together.

EXAMPLE:

ship
/sh/ /i/ /p/



2 BUILD IT

Use magnetic letters or
letter cards to build
the word.

EXAMPLE:

brain



3 WRITE IT

Ask your child to write
the word using their
phonics.

EXAMPLE:

train



4 SPOT THE TRICKY BIT

For tricky (common exception)
words, find the part that
needs to be remembered.

EXAMPLE:

said

The ai is the tricky bit!

LOOK
SAY
COVER
WRITE
CHECK

5 USE IT

Put the word into a sentence
or find it in a book.

EXAMPLE:

The train is big.
