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Pupil Voice:

As many of you know, our School Council meets once a fortnight with Mrs. Jones. One child from each of our year groups has been democratically voted onto the School Council by the other children in their year group; the council has a Chair, a Secretary and a Treasurer. The council represents all the children in the school: when we make changes in school the School Council ensures that the children's views form part of our decision-making process, and they fundraise for local charities of their choice.

Every other week, each class holds a Class Council Meeting. The representative on the School Council will tell their class about what the School Council discussed the week before, collecting feedback from the class, and they'll ask the class if there's anything the children would like raised at the next School Council Meeting.

We also carry out termly surveys to find out whether there's anything we can do to improve the school for the children.

In addition to all of this we are currently growing the group of Curriculum Ambassadors which Miss Hodges and I started last year...they support the staff team with further refining of our curriculum and learning for all our children.

Parent Voice:

We carry out one Parent Survey each year, and publish the outcomes of this in a school newsletter; making any changes we can to further improve our parents' and carers' experience at Glade Academy.

However, we currently have very little parent representation within our community.

We have always had a Local Governing Body and whilst we have lots of parents and carers who are part of our community, we currently have just one parent who is part of this group.

We held Parent Forum Meetings in the autumn term last year (one during the school day, the other after school) and just three parents came to this (the same parents attended both meetings).

We have had our CoGS group for several years now (Community of Glade School); this is now made up entirely of members of staff.

We would love to have more parent and carer representation within our community. For some of the above groups you would need to have a DBS check...but your involvement can be as little or as much as you wish. If you're interested...please read on..!



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Local Governing Body:

Our Local Governing Body meets once every half-term (each six weeks). They review some of the school's paperwork and policies and help us make some decisions about what happens in the school, and how these things happen. They help monitor the work of the school by coming in to meet with members of staff and children. As an example, you might be particularly interested in finding out more about the impact of our teaching of phonics on children...you could meet with Mrs. Peck to find out about our phonics scheme and the way we teach phonics, you could spend some time in the classes where phonics is specifically taught (EYFS, Y1 and Y2) and you could meet with a group of children so they can talk to you about what they do in phonics lessons, how they feel about different activities in phonics lessons, and how they think this learning helps them learn to read.

Time Commitment:

- One 1.5 to 2 hour meeting at school every six weeks (usually during Monday mornings);
- Paperwork to review in preparation for the meeting the paperwork is shared at least a week before the meeting);
- One monitoring visit (e.g. meeting with a member of staff, talking to some children) a term...although more can be arranged!

CoGS:

Our CoGS meet on a regular basis after school, it's informal and friendly; they discuss fund raising ideas. The focus is on raising money to spend on the children and school, through fun activities which families and children will enjoy!

Time Commitment:

Your involvement can be as little or as much as you like...you could help set up for a Bingo event, you could wash uniform donated to the school and organise this for the Uniform Exchange (we have a washing machine and airer in the staffroom which we use for this). You could be a core part of a group organising a larger event like a Christmas Fayre, or you could simply help with selling refreshments before the Christmas Nativity Play.

If you would like to find out any more information about being part of our Local Governing Body or CoGS group, or you have any questions, then please speak to me when I'm on gate duty, or message me on Dojo and I will happily do my best to answer.

Please be aware, we don't currently have any parent / carer volunteers helping in school...please do let me know if you'd like to find out more about this.
