Dear Parents and Carers,

It's been lovely to see so many of you at our Sharing Assemblies and our Parents' Cafes...I know that the children have enjoyed having you there too!

Thank you also to the parents who have been able to attend the information sessions which Miss Goody, Mrs. Peck and Mr. McDonald have been running on:

- Early Years phonics and reading;
- Year One phonics;
- End of Key Stage One reading and maths;
- Year Four multiplication test;
- End of Key Stage Two reading, writing and maths assessments.

I know from the feedback I've had about these sessions that parents have found them extremely useful. These sessions will be repeated and I strongly recommend that when the next set of dates are released as many parents and carers as possible do their best to attend them.

Research shows that children who achieve the age-related expectation of good GCSE results are more likely to be successful and happy in life when they are grown-up.



Children who achieve age related expectations and pass their Key Stage Two SATs in reading, writing and maths at the age of 11 are more likely to achieve age related expectations in their GCSEs.



Children who achieve age related expectations and pass their Key Stage One SATs in reading, writing and maths at the age of 7 are more likely to achieve age related expectations in their KS2 SATs.



Children who achieve age related expectations and pass their Year One Phonics Test at the age of 6 are more likely to achieve age related expectations in their KS1 SATs.



And children who achieve age related expectations and GLD (a Good Level of Development) at the age of 5 at the end of their Reception year are more likely to pass their Year One Phonics Test.

We are doing everything we can to ensure that all children at Glade have the best possible opportunities to become happy and successful adults.



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The weather is definitely starting to turn; even though the sun is often out the wind is becoming sharper and there's a definite nip in the air...please make sure that your children come to school dressed ready for the cold, wind and rain.
